The total labour force (aged above 15) is 55.16 million, of which approximately 21.8% have qualification certificates.



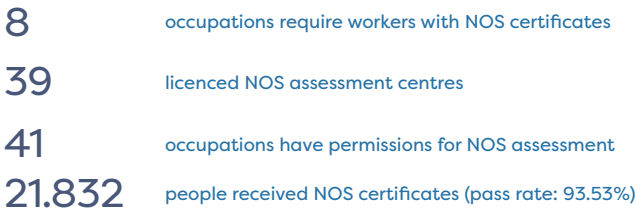
Unemployment

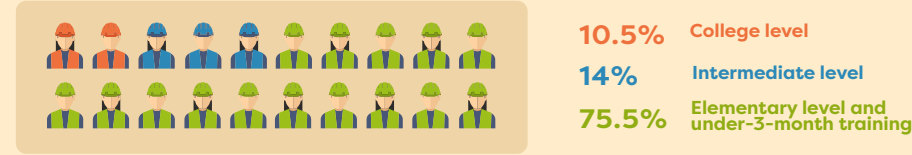

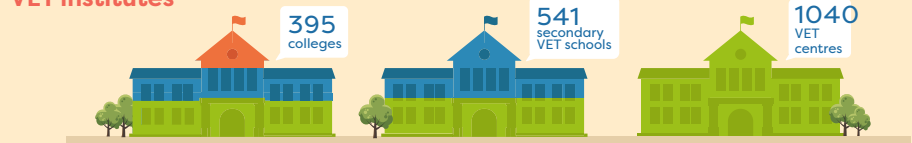

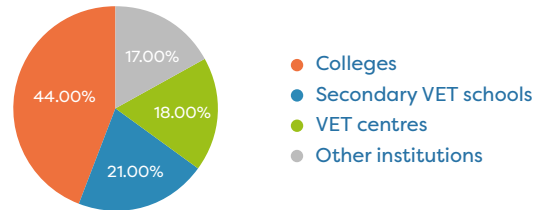

Distribution of teaching staff by VET institutes



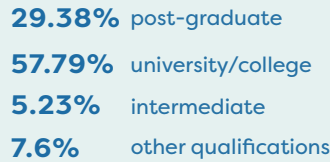
MANAGERS

7.5% enterprises have cooperation with VET institutes

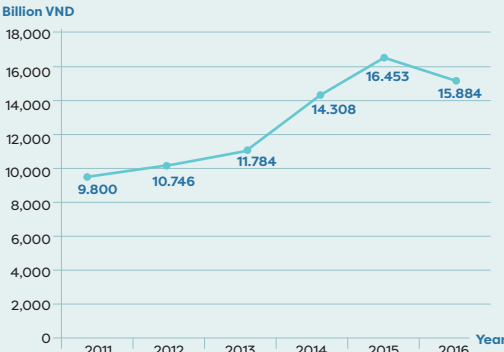


35.2% enterprises provide training for employees, of which 79% organise training by themselves

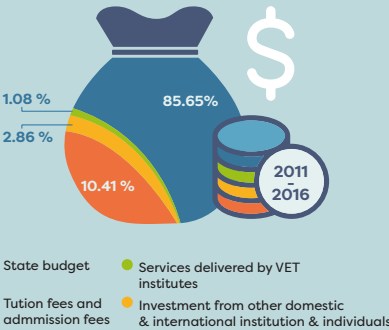
