Ms. Bui Thi Quynh Dung - the resilient Mechatronics trainee from Bac Ninh Industrial College (BCI) has always been into machinery and is often the family member to fix and install electrical appliances at home.

However, because her parents wanted her to have a physically light job, Dung decided to work as a garment worker at a factory. For nearly six years, the tedious nature of her job and the low pay made Dung want to quit several times, but she needed the source of income to sustain herself.

It was during the more difficult period of Covid-19 in 2021 that Dung found a strong reason to leave her job. With an aim to improving her technical skills for a better-paying and more secure job, Dung applied to the Mechatronics Programme at BCI.

2021 was a challenging period for Dung as she had to work part-time while pursuing her studies in Mechatronics at BCI. She would go to college in the morning or afternoon, and she would go to work when she does not have classes. After two years of hard work, Dung proved to herself to her parents that she was capable and passionate in her pursuit of a career in electricals, and that there was no such thing as a gender-exclusive job.

Exciting news for Viet Nam's efforts to become a carbon-neutral economy!

The Vietnamese government has set a goal to achieve net carbon emissions by 2050, and the GIZ Energy and TVET clusters are teaming up to support the effort. To help with the transition, RECOTVET has partnered with the CASE project and the National Assembly of Vietnam to assess the employment and skill needs for the Just Energy Transition (JET) in Viet Nam.

This analysis will help forecast the employment and skill needs for key renewable technologies and take into account the potential job opportunities for women. The initial findings will be shared with national partners in the third quarter of this year. Through their collaboration, GIZ's Energy and TVET clusters hope to make a valuable contribution to Vietnam's resource planning and support a Just Energy Transition to a sustainable and equitable carbon-neutral economy.
